Additional clinics now offered at Greenfield branch include: dedicated skin lesion (Dr Rankin), antenatal (Midwife Sheena), Ultrasound and Talking Therapy.

The direct dial phone number for Greenfield site remains the same although the computer booking system is fully integrated across all three sites and can be accessed via all receptionists.

We are excited to be able to provide updates relating to new services that have been introduced for patients, staff developments and further information about our Greenfield branch.

New Services:

We introduce a new **wellness practitioner** to our team - Emily Skee. She works all day on Thursdays (Sunny Meed hub) offering face to face appointments for adults who might benefit from additional wellbeing support, guidance or signposting to local services including charities. She helps coordinate support for all patients and carers, working closely with the clinical and administrative team to. Please book via reception or ask a member of the clinical team.

Our **First Contact Physio** clinic on Wednesday mornings (Sunny Meed hub) is proving popular with patients and compliments other clinics held locally. Receptionists and clinicians directly book these appointments.

On Thursday afternoons (Greenfield branch) Dr Paul Rankin runs a **skin lesion clinic** where he can review skin lesions using a dermatoscope.

We continue to offer Saturday morning bloods at the Bedser Hub in Woking Community Hospital – bookings for these are made via reception. Please remember to take your blood test form to all appointments.

Our practice manager Filippa Dilena is joined by Petra Barrett, an experienced practice manager who works Tuesdays and Fridays. We are delighted to welcome her to the team.
